This year we will be celebrating over 50 great years of golf, fun and fellowship. Many things have changed dramatically over the last 50 years, and not always for the best. However, this tournament has remained a constant amid all the change around it. The premise for this tournament, from its humble beginning in 1957 to present day, was, and always will be, to provide a venue for Delta golfers to come together for spirited competition, good fellowship, to renew old acquaintances and/or, make new ones. That has not changed!

TRAVEL

Our passenger loads into and out of Orlando continue to be extremely heavy, and passing is always difficult. You might consider TPA as an alternate city. Plan accordingly.

Driving directions from Atlanta: South on Interstate 75 to the Florida turnpike. South on the turnpike to Hwy. 429 (toll) toward I-4. When Hwy. 429 merges into I-4, remain in the right lane and exit at Hwy. 532, which is exit # 58. Left on Hwy. 532 and look for the Reunion entrance on your left.

TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM MCO

Mears Transportation has shuttle service between MCO and Reunion. Price is \$19.00 OW/\$31.00 RT. Expect a 20-30 minute wait once at airport and checked in with Mears. They do not take reservations, and the return trip portion will require a call 24 hours prior to departure. They require return to be 3 hours prior to scheduled flight departure.

TRANSPORTATION WHILE ON PROPERTY.

Tram service is available on a call basis. The number to call for pickup is Extension 3745.

CHECK -IN AND CHECK-OUT: If at any time you have questions regarding your reservations, feel free to call Reunion reservations at 1-888-418-9611 to confirm. We strongly recommend you call Reunion direct between the hours of 8:00AM-5:30PM, Monday-Friday, and 9:00 AM-4:00 PM on Saturday. Closed on Sunday. At any other times you will get Central reservations, not Reunion direct!!

A Committee member will be on hand during check-in on Friday to assist with any problems.

Check-in:

All participants must be registered on a Reunion package. Normal check-in is 4:00 PM; however, early check-in will be permitted if space is available. If your room isn't available at check-in, you will be allowed to play golf on Friday without being assigned a room. You will receive a Reunion identification card. **Keep the identification card with you at all times!** This will be your admittance to breakfast and evening functions. Local golfers (without room accommodations) must check-in at the Reunion registration desk on Friday to receive identification cards.

Reunion is giving all Delta golfers a 2 for 1 drink special in the lobby bar, 5pm-7pm, Friday through Sunday. Just show your Reunion I.D. card. One drink special per person please.

IMPORTANT!!!!REUNION IS A CASHLESS RESORT. YOU WILL NEED YOUR ID CARD FOR ANY AND ALL PURCHASES AT THE RESORT. IT IS ALSO YOUR ROOM KEY!!!!

The only exceptions to the above statement is you will be able to pay cash to the committee for raffle tickets, the putting contest and mulligans at the Friday Scramble..

Gratuities-Not allowed for any reason whatsoever. Please do not offer a gratuity to any Reunion staff member.

Delta Registration:

The committee will have a registration desk in the **Reunion Grande** on Friday, Sept. 7, from **0630 to 1600**. **All participants must register!** Tee packages will be distributed at this time.

If you were a late entry and/or haven't paid your entry fee, or if you are not listed on the pairings, you will need to get your course and hole assignments at check-in as well as remit your entry fee. Also, if you did not turn in a score, please give this information at check-in in order for you to be flighted. This includes the VIP flight as well.

Check-out:

On Sunday, if you need a late check out, please advise the front desk with an approximate time for your departure. This request will need to be made as early as possible. They will do all possible to accommodate your request. Your cooperation will be appreciated.

Express check-out is available to you, and is a highly recommended method of checking out at Reunion. Details are on the Reunion channel of your television.

The 2007 Friday Scramble will be held on Friday, September 7th, at the Independence (Watson) Golf Course. Check in for the scramble begins at **06:45** and play will begin with a shotgun start at **07:30**. Everyone needs to be in their carts and ready to go by **0715**. Mulligans are on sale at check in for \$3.00 ea. or 2 for \$5.00. **Cash will be accepted by the committee for the sale of mulligans!!**

There will be a long drive contest, hole to be announced at check in. Closest to pin contests will be held on designated par 3's. There will be awards to the winners. Plaques are awarded for 1st place low gross and 1st place low net.

FRIDAY PUTTING CONTEST!!

A putting contest will be held at the Watson/Palmer Clubhouse putting green. We will begin at 10:00 AM. No entries will be accepted after 4:00 PM. This will be a nine hole event. Tournament Details:

- Dress Code*** All participants must wear shirts either with a collar, or the newly accepted mock turtlenecks. No cutoffs are allowed. Also, Reunion is a soft spike facility.
- Golf Bags*** Reunion will keep your bag in storage and have it at your designated course and starting time.
- Awards*** Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third place in each flight. In case of ties, the Golf Committee will choose a method to determine the winner.
- Flights*** Each player has been assigned a flight based upon the average that you submitted, or from previous tournament records. After first round scores have been posted, anyone without a tournament history who scores 10 or more strokes under the average turned in will be subject to re-fighting to a lower flight.

Rules of Play

1. Tees for play for all players, including Seniors/Super Seniors, will be denoted on your scorecard and/or the rules sheet which will be in each and every cart.
2. Improve the lie of the ball in your own fairway, no closer to the hole.
3. Out of bounds or lost ball-One shot penalty and drop ball on line that ball went out of bounds or in area that ball is lost. Do not go back to tee.
4. Gimmie putts-all putts within 24 inches will be considered as a gimmie. Method to determine the 24 inches will be established, i.e., tape on flagstick, etc.
5. The first name in each foursome is designated as "Captain" and is responsible for enforcing rules of play.
6. Local rules will be applied in other conditions.
7. A **double par** stroke maximum for a hole is in effect. Pick up and go to the next hole.

A rules sheet will be placed in each cart to aid you during play!

Scoring-All players

1. Each player must turn in an official scorecard that is completed, signed and attested, to a member of the committee, or to one of the lady volunteers, at the scoreboards in the hospitality tent.

The completed cards must be received by our scorers no later than one hour after your completion of play!

2. Any cards that are not completed as described and showing a total for each nine and a total for 18 holes ***will be disqualified!***
3. It is the player's responsibility to add the score card correctly.

Winner's scorecards are verified and anyone signing a card with a lower score is disqualified. We have 3-4 DQ's each year, so **PLEASE CHECK YOUR ADDITION!**

We need your help to ensure the rounds are completed in a timely manner. Please avoid slow play and adhere to the modified rules as described below.

Please help avoid 5 hour rounds. The following guidelines will help.

1. Limit your search for lost balls to 3 minutes **OR LESS.**
2. Park your carts away from the approach areas of the green.
3. Play "ready" golf.
4. Be considerate and courteous of others.
5. A **double par** stroke maximum for a hole is in effect. Pick up and go to the next hole.

Note: Reunion marshals will be on the course to help speed up play.

Master Scoreboards

These will be located under the tent located behind the Reunion Grande throughout the tournament, except for Saturday night when they will be displayed in the Reunion Grande Ballroom.

VIP Board

The suppliers and sponsors who play in this tournament are invaluable to its success. In order to recognize them properly we will have a VIP listing displayed near the scoreboards. The name of the company, as well as the names of individuals representing that company, will be listed.
